Disaster Recovery Fund Established

Community Foundation for the Alleghenies (CFA) has partnered with Somerset County Commissioners to establish the Somerset County Disaster Recovery Fund in response to the recent flooding in the southern part of the county.

“As the cleanup and recovery process gets into its next phase, this fund will provide needed financial support to local organizations assisting our friends and neighbors impacted by the flooding with unmet needs and provide a place to donate for all who have asked us how they can help,” said Chair of Somerset County Board of Commissioners Brian Fochtman.

The fund is now accepting donations, which will be disbursed immediately to nonprofits that are assisting Somerset County residents with flooding response and recovery. Following the current flooding recovery, the fund will remain open in support of future natural disasters and other crisis situations in Somerset County.

To oversee the distribution of these grant funds, the Commissioners are working closely with the Somerset County Emergency Management Agency to organize an advisory committee, which will include the social service, faith-based, and emergency response communities.

The Community Foundation is committing a grant of \$10,000 in order to get the fund started. To donate, please make your check payable to the Somerset County Disaster Recovery Fund, and mail it to 216 Franklin Street, Suite 400, Johnstown, PA 15901, or visit <https://www.cfalleghenies.org/>

Disaster Recovery Help

At the request of county officials, the state will support a Multi-Agency Resource Center (MARC) to assist individuals, families and businesses that sustained losses from significant flooding May 13 & 14, 2025.

The MARC will be located at the Meyersdale Volunteer Fire Department, 202 Main Street, Meyersdale. It will be open Thursday through Saturday, May 22 – 24, 10AM to 7PM. Residents from Somerset Co. and nearby Pennsylvania communities that were affected by the flooding are encouraged to attend the MARC.

Multiple Somerset Co., PA agencies and offices will be available to provide local services. Pennsylvania state agencies scheduled to participate or provide information include:

- PA Emergency Management Agency.

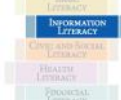
