Elks Lodge Annual Flag Day Service

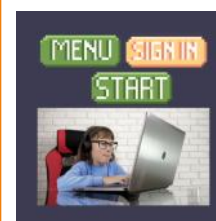
June 14th 2026, 6:30PM

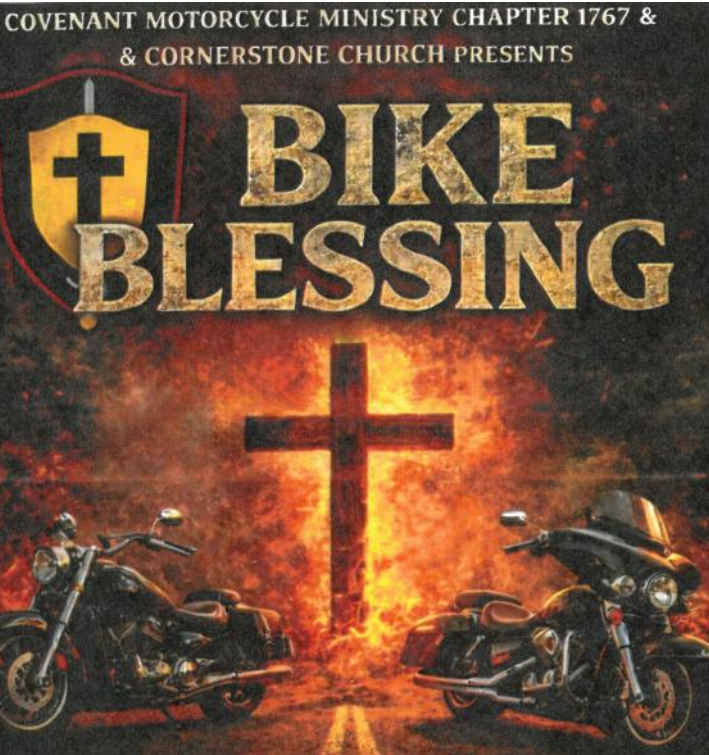

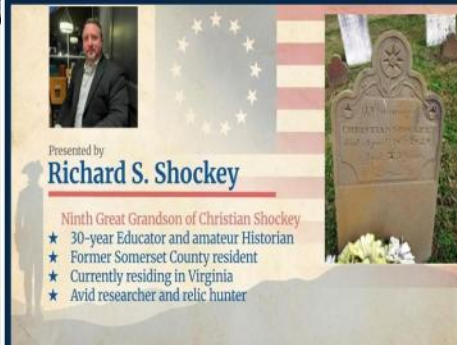
