Meyersdale Church Of The Brethren is celebrating the 100th anniversary of the first worship service held in their present church building.

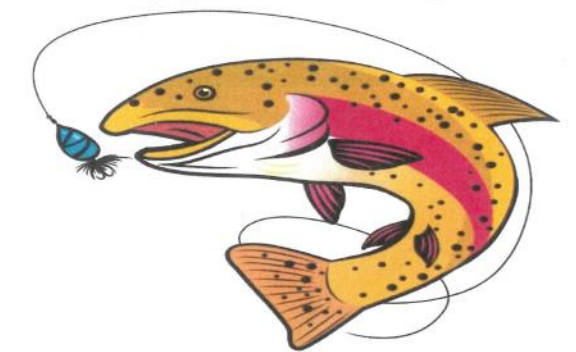
