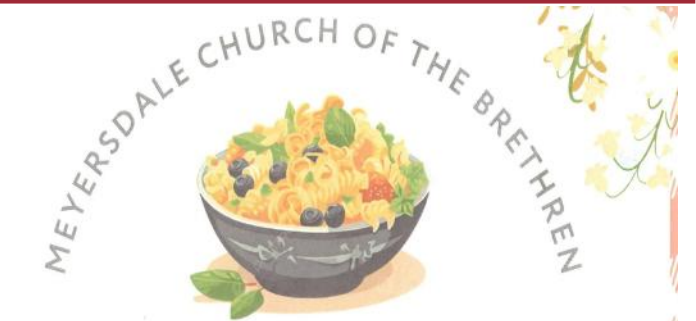
Loose rubbish must be in containers limited to 40 pounds each. Furniture items are allowed.

Trash should be out the night before or by 5 a.m.



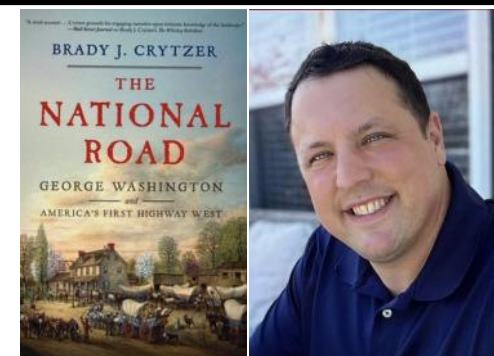
