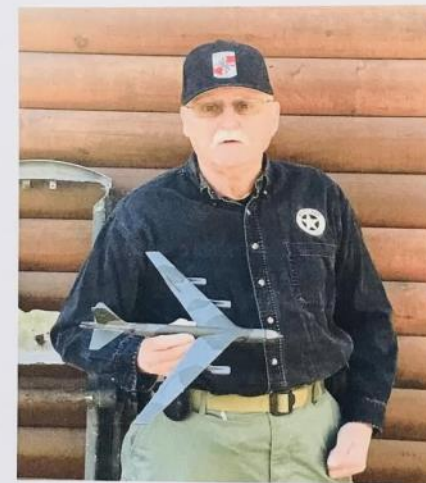
### Meyersdale Senior Center
