DISASTER RECOVERY ASSISTANCE

Meyersdale Borough Council has received grant funds to assist residents that have sustained loss of appliances as a result of the May 13, 2025 flooding event. In order to be eligible for assistance, you must live within the Meyersdale Borough limits, be a homeowner with direct flood damage on or about May 13, 2025, and must provide receipts of purchased appliances and photos of damage to property, if available. Applications for assistance are available at the Meyersdale Community Center during normal business hours. The deadline to make application is July 31, 2025 at Noon.

Return application to the Borough Office in a sealed envelope clearly marked DISASTER RECOVERY ASSISTANCE COMPLETED APPLICATION ENCLOSED.
