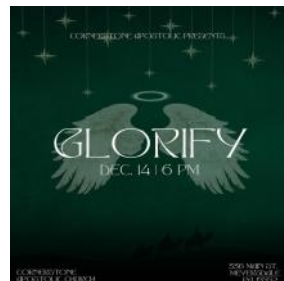

**RECYCLING PROGRAM**

The Fourth Friday from 4:00pm to 5:00pm (FFFF) there will be community recycling drop off in the Meyersdale Elementary Parking Lot.

**Accepted Recyclables**

- Corrugated Cardboard: Please flatten!
- Cereal-Box Cardboard: Can be combined with corrugated cardboard.
- Styrofoam: Must snap when bent.
- Plastic Containers: Squash containers (with or without caps). Must display a triangle with number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7. All numbers can now be co-mingled.
- Soft Sheet Plastic: Crumple easily, such as grocery bags.
- Aluminum Cans/Scrap Metal: Squash if possible. Use a magnet. If it does not stick, it is not aluminum.
- Tin Cans: No need to remove labels, but squash them!
- Paper: Place in small bags (heavy items), separate newspaper, junk mail, and magazines.
- Glass: Only food or beverage containers. Place in a box or crate, not bags!

**Repurpose Items**

- Bubble Wrap & Shipping Materials: Reuse for future shipments.
- Egg Crates: Keep them intact (please don't break or tear them apart).
- Shredded Paper: Place in tied bags (this is the only exception for tied bags).

**Important!**  
All items must be clean and not mixed with different types of materials.
