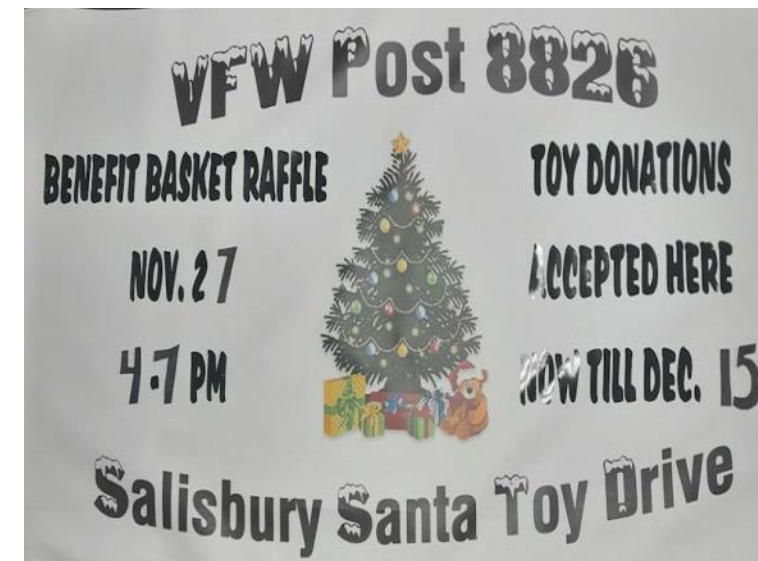
We are hosting a toy drive up through Dec.

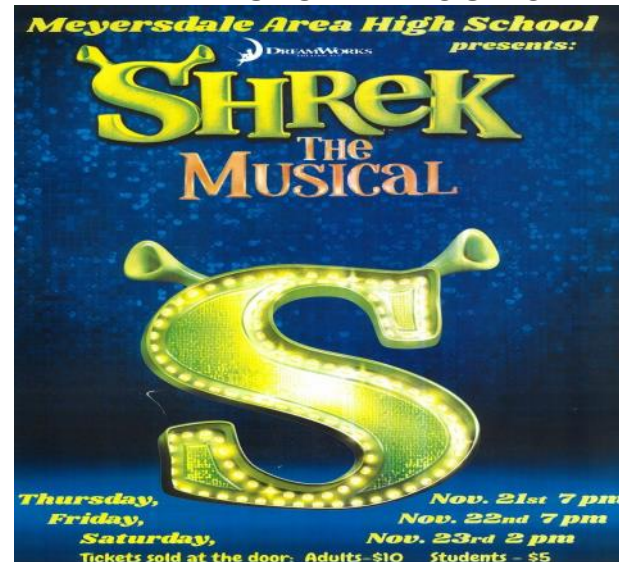

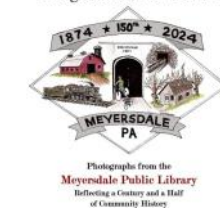
