Salisbury Elk-Lick Schools Notice

Salisbury-Elk Lick Schools will open for students on Mon., Aug. 31, 2026, at the normal starting time. Dismissal will be at 1:15 P.M.

For security purposes, bus schedules will not be posted. If you should have a question regarding your child's bus information, please call the school at 662-2733 ext. 6800.

Students should arrive at school between 7:50 and 8:10 A.M. (If eating breakfast, students should arrive by 8:00). Students will be considered tardy after 8:10 AM in the high school and 8:15 AM in the elementary school. Students will be dismissed at 3:18 PM

During inclement weather, school closings will be announced on the following radio station no later than 7AM: Big Froggy-WFRB 105.3, (AKA Forever Media – Cumberland stations) and WJAC-TV (ch. 6). Parents will also be notified by phone through our Thrill Share System. Call the school to update phone numbers for the Thrill Share system.

Salisbury-Elk Lick School District will be implementing a program known as the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) in the 2026-27 school year. This program is available to schools and districts that are participating in the National School Breakfast and lunch Programs. All enrolled students of Salisbury-Elk Lick School District are eligible to receive a nutritional breakfast and lunch each school day at no charge to your household.

Any ala carte items, additional breakfast or lunch purchases, or Kindergarten snack purchases will be subject to a charge and account balances will be managed per student handbook and school district policy. If your child had an outstanding balance at the end of 2025-26 school year, it would carry over to this current school year. Kindergarten snacks are not included in the CEP program.
