- Weakness or tiredness
- Cool, pale, clammy skin
- Fast, weak pulse
- Muscle cramps
- Dizziness
- Nausea or vomiting
- Headache
- Fainting

TAKE ACTION

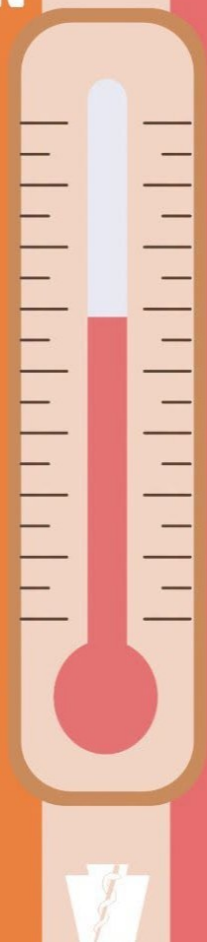
- Move person to a cooler spot
- Loosen clothing
- Apply cool, wet cloths
- Offer sips of water

HEAT STROKE SYMPTOMS

- Throbbing headache
- Confusion
- Slurred speech
- Nausea
- Dizziness
- Body temperature $>103^{\circ}\text{F}$
- Hot, red, dry or damp skin
- Rapid and strong pulse
- Loss of consciousness

TAKE ACTION

- **Call 911**
- Move person to a cooler spot
- Loosen clothing
- Apply cool, wet cloths
- **DO NOT** offer water
