Meyersdale 150th Anniversary is here!

Festivities will kick off at noon Feb. 19 when the churches in Meyersdale will ring their bells. This marks the anniversary of the day Meyersdale was incorporated.

Feb. 23-25, the Meyersdale Community Murder Mystery play will incorporate historical information during the performances in the Meyersdale Volunteer Fire Department social room.

The Meyersdale American Legion Auxiliary spearheaded a campaign for banners sponsored by area businesses that will include the Sesquicentennial logo to be displayed along Main and Center streets during the year.

The Friends of the Library group is sponsoring an historical picture book edited by library archivist Jennifer Hurl. Joyce Nalley is working on a Cat's Meow collector item with the Sesquicentennial logo.

The 50th anniversary of the "Legend of the Magic Water" will feature the 150th anniversary during the performances at the BPOE Elks Lodge during the PA Maple Festival April 20-21, and 24-28. The Maple Festival will have a coloring contest going out to the local schools, a special feature at the quilt show, and the queen's contest will include an essay on community history for the contestants to write. Window displays and the Grand Feature Parade during the festival will include a special 150th category.

The BPOE Elks is hosting a 150th banquet May 4. It will include special guests, music by the Meyersdale Area High School jazz band, and Mike Petenbrink and John Sines are donating photos for a fundraiser. The Meyersdale Garden Club will put together the table centerpieces.

Meyersdale Church of the Brethren is planning a celebration marking the first church service held 100 years ago in May.

The Meyersdale Volunteer Fire Department is celebrating its 125th anniversary June 8 with a special anniversary dinner.

The Appalachian Wagon Train will be set up June 16-22, at the Wendell Yoder farm. On that Tuesday, June 18, they'd like to bring the wagon train through Meyersdale at noon. The Meyersdale Area Merchants Association hopes to promote National Picnic Day at the same time to encourage people to bring a picnic lunch to the gazebo park and watch the wagon train.

A time capsule, sponsored by Michael and Kristine Mishler, will be installed in September at the Doughboy Monument. They will take suggestions to what to put into the capsule.

Oct. 19 a community church choir concert will be held at Amity UCC, followed by tours of the churches in town, and a dinner at the Meyersdale fire hall to commemorate the 50th year anniversary of 4 Guys Inc.

The Sesquicentennial year will wrap up Thanksgiving weekend, with the annual Light Up Night/Christmas at the Manor celebration hosted by the PA Maple Festival.
